

Warrenville Independence Eve Parade - Instructions
Thursday, July 3, 2008

Parents, please remember to have your cell-phone with you, and on, in case we need to reach you for any unforeseen reason on the day of the parade.

All Parade Participants –

Review and adhere to the complete Marching Dress Code found on the Summer Marching web page. Bring your hat. Musicians, bring instrument, lyre and flip-folder with music as directed.

Parade Participants Drop-Off– CHECK-IN between 4:30 and 5 PM

The WSHSB's line-up number is unit #16. The staging area for our unit is on Manning Avenue between Mount Street and Warren Avenue. Look for folks in neon vests for line-up assistance. Stay to the side to allow for traffic flow. Parking space is very tight. **DO NOT PARK IN THE CITY HALL LOT BY THE GAZEBO, 28W630 Stafford Place.** This space is needed for staging. We've been strongly encouraged to park at Bower School at 4S241 River Road for pick-ups afterwards.

Bathrooms - Open bathrooms will be available at the Warrenville Recreation Center at the corner of Warren Avenue and Tracy Place.

New Parade Route – Step-off is at 6 PM at intersection of Curtis Avenue, Tracy Place and Warren Avenue.

Due to construction on Warrenville Road the route is as follows:

Step off at intersection of Curtis Avenue, Tracy Place and Warren Avenue.

South on Warren Avenue to Woodlawn Avenue

West on Woodlawn Ave to Curtis Avenue

South on Curtiss Avenue to end at Woodland Road

(The reviewing stand will be at Curtis and Forest View Avenue)

NOTE: While the parade officially ends at Woodland Road, we will continue to march a little further south on Curtis Avenue to the Woodland School, 4S208 Curtis Ave. We will disperse from there.

Pick-up after the parade Pick-ups are at the Woodland School, 4S208 Curtis Ave. where there is limited parking. It is just south of Woodland Road on the west side of Curtis Ave. Additional parking is at Bower School, 4S241 River Road, a little north of Ferry Road.
