

**West Chicago Railroad Days Parade - Instructions**  
**Sunday, July 13, 2006**

**Parents, please remember to have your cell-phone with you, and on, in case we need to reach you for any unforeseen reason on the day of the parade.**

**All Parade Participants –**

Review and adhere to the complete Marching Dress Code found on the Summer Marching web page. Bring your hat. Musicians, bring instrument, lyre and flip-folder with music as directed. Remember to apply sunscreen beforehand.

**Parade Participants – CHECK-IN 12:00 Noon**

There is no designated drop-off point for the West Chicago Railroad Days parade. **WSHSB's line-up number is I60**, which is on Elite Avenue between Grand Lake Boulevard and Elmwood Avenue.

**Bathrooms** - There will be two portable toilets on Elmwood Avenue which cuts through the staging area.

**Parade Route** - The 2008 Railroad Days parade will be stepping off from the intersection of Elmwood Avenue and Ingaltan Avenue. It will proceed south on Ingaltan Avenue to Washington Street, west on Washington Street to Arbor Avenue, continuing north on Arbor Avenue to National Street, by Reed Keppler Park. We will then continue east on National Street, turning south on Elite Avenue, returning to our original line-up spot.

**Pick-up after the parade** will be on Elite Avenue, where we lined-up before the parade.
