

West Chicago Railroad Days Parade - Instructions
Sunday, July 11, 2010

Parents, please remember to have your cell-phone with you, and on, in case we need to reach you for any unforeseen reason on the day of the parade.

In case of threatening weather –

Since the director does not run the parades and weather is beyond her control it is a parent's decision whether or not their child participates if weather is threatening. The director will always be present at the parade, for those who decide to attend. If rain is predicted, those marching should bring a clear poncho. Inexpensive ones can be purchased at Target or Wal-Mart.

All Parade Participants –

Review and adhere to the complete Marching Dress Code found on the Summer Marching web page. Bring your hat. Musicians, bring instrument, lyre and flip-folder with music as directed. Remember to apply sunscreen beforehand. Water must be in a color-coordinated container as discussed at camp.

Parade Participants – CHECK-IN 12:00 Noon

There is no designated drop-off point for the West Chicago Railroad Days parade. **WSHSB's line-up number is 31**, which is on Highland Avenue north of Elmwood and south of National Street.

Bathrooms - There will be at least one portable toilet at the intersection of National and Highland.

Parade Route - The 2010 Railroad Days parade will be stepping off from the intersection of Elmwood and Ingaltion Avenues. It will proceed south on Ingaltion Avenue to Washington Street, west on Washington Street to Arbor Avenue, continuing north on Arbor Avenue to National Street, by Reed Keppler Park. We will then continue east on National Street, turning south on Highland Avenue, returning to our original line-up spot.

Pick-up after the parade will be on Highland Avenue, where we lined-up before the parade.
