

Marching music to keep

If you are marching in any parade this summer, or participating in the DuPage County Fair, Opening Day in July, you need to bring your marching instrument, a lyre and flip folder this Thursday, 5/19. You do not need a music stand. You need to keep one or two songs in your flip folder, as follows -

Summer Parade participants will need this song in their flip folders -
Zaketekas (Cadets will be receiving this song)

DuPage County Fair, Opening Day participants will need this song in their flip folders –
Spirit of America

With the exception of the two songs to be kept by those participating in marching band this summer, there should be **no other music remaining** in anyone's folder, or in piles in your home.

There is much music to return. Please be considerate of others. To help the long lines move smoothly, prepare your music for collection, **at home**. Do not wait until you arrive at band, or in line, to start pulling and organizing music. Remove all music from page protectors and arrange in alphabetical order as listed below. Keep each band's music separate. Some songs are listed under more than one band. Turn it in for your primary band. There are special instructions for returning Minutemen music, and a list of Miscellaneous music, which includes Bongo Louie for the percussionists to return.

As you turn in each song, state your name and the song title to the person checking the music in. Make sure they mark your name off their list.
